MCT Overview

MyCreditsTransfer (MCT) is a statewide initiative that makes information available to students via the free web-based tool, Transferology™ (https://www.transferology.com/). The MCT Project seeks to aid all students who intend to transfer credits among Illinois higher education institutions. Students can create personal accounts through which they can track their progress toward specific degrees at institutions where they have not yet matriculated. The information made available to transfer students through Transferology™ helps enable them to make the most of their time and money as they work toward degree completion.

One intended outcome of MCT is to provide students who are underrepresented in higher education access to information about how they can most efficiently transfer to baccalaureate-granting institutions. The goal is to see larger numbers of underrepresented minority students transferring and a greater proportion of those students moving from community colleges to Illinois senior institutions.

MCT's Outlined Goals

- 1. Increase implementation and usage by Illinois' 85 participating colleges and universities
- 2. Promote use of Transferology™ to relevant audiences through presentations and training
- 3. Maintain project infrastructure
- 4. Collaborate with organizations, agencies and associations involved in transfer
- 5. Evaluate the effectiveness of the project and the tool for enhancements

FY '25 Quick Facts

- Illinois Transferology™ network = 85 participating colleges and universities
- Illinois colleges/universities published 6,345,447 transfer equivalencies through Transferology, including 11,996 articulations of IAI approved courses.
- Illinois usage: Transferology sessions (student visits) = 490,960; Transferology Lab sessions (advisor visits) = 100,041
- Users ran 14,973 'what if' degree audits from 6 institutions, and were connected to degree planning resources for 21 Illinois colleges/universities
- MCT staff performed 59 training sessions for 223 participants at 34 Illinois colleges/universities
- MCT staff made 13 presentations for 860 attendees
- MCT staff performed demonstrations for 243 students
- MCT maintained 2 support websites: MyCreditsTransfer.org/support and Transferready.org, that provide transfer advising resources
- MCT participates in and co-chairs the Interstate Transfer Council (ITC) a multi-state group that shares transfer solutions and best practices among 8 states
